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Skill Building

Over the last four years, our summer literacy program has proven to yield significant student growth. In summer 2024, students in Grades 1-9 achieved 19 percentage points of proficiency growth in literacy and 21 percentage points of proficiency growth in math from the pre to the post assessment.

In addition, a study conducted by the Indiana Department of Education found that students using the RISE literacy program made statistically significant growth on their end-of-year state assessments.

The RISE curriculum team has hand-selected texts with relatable characters, situations, and themes. Our Summer School text list is designed to both reflect the identities, experiences, and motivations of students in your classroom while also providing insight and perspective into the lives of others.

As students engage with each text, they engage in discussions to identify and trace the development of a theme while also deepening their understanding of the author's craft, such as symbolism, motifs, figurative language, and mood.
